B. TRAINING OBJECTIVE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

I. Training Objectives

1. General objectives

The postgraduate program in economic law at Tay Do university is applied to help students supplement and enhance their knowledge and methods of study of economic law at an intensive level for legal professionals working in state agencies, enterprises, academic institutions, law firms, law offices, other organizations, etc. To help learners apply that knowledge to their professional practices, to be able to work independently, to think creatively, and to have the ability to identify and solve problems in the field, specialized training is needed.

About knowledge

Have an understanding of the role of information and communication technology in the business production operations of enterprises in the digital age.

Have in-depth knowledge of content design methodologies and information architecture to support business strategies across multiple digital platforms.

Have in-depth knowledge of data mining and analysis to effectively measure and evaluate business information and communication strategies across digital platforms.

About skills

-Professional skills: learn, master, and use the basic skills in law-making, law-application, trial, legal advice, and legal support for the community; have methods and skills to analyze, debate, present opinions, and make legal arguments in the environment of legal practice.

-Communication skills and teamwork: learn how to interact, coordinate in teamwork, or have the ability to work independently when performing professional activities.

About ability and positioning after graduation

Graduates of master's degrees in applied law training can engage in professional work in the following positions:

- Judicial posts (lawyers, judges, inspectors, civil servants, executives, successors, etc.);

- Legal consultancy;

-Legal work in state bodies such as Parliament, government, people's councils at all levels, and people's committees at various levels;

- Legal work in ministries and sectors;

- Internal lawyers, legal advisors, and legal practitioners in political and social organizations; social and professional organizations;

- Possibility of continuing to participate in the law doctoral degree program after completing a number of courses in the master's degree program based on the research orientation of the respective specialty.
