2. Degree:	Undergraduate
3. Training codes:	7340201
4. Admission candidates:	Following the current University Admission Regulations of the Ministry of Education and Training and Tay Do University, Vietnamese citizens who meet the following conditions are eligible to register for admission: - Having a high school Diploma or equivalent under the regulations of the Ministry of Education and Training; - Be healthy enough to study and work according to current regulations of the Ministry of Health, Education and Training; - Submit all documents and registration fees in full and on time according to the regulations of the Ministry of Education and Training.
5. Training time:	3.5 years (3 semesters/year)

7. Required credits:	130 credits (not included physical education and national defense education)

9. Diploma:	Bachelor of Finance and Banking
10. Working position:	Students graduating from the Finance and Banking program are capable of working at banking and non-banking financial institutions and relevant state management agencies with positions such as credit specialist, customer relations, international payment, foreign exchange business, capital management, risk management, financial consultant, teller, accountant, financial specialist, broker, investment analyst, investor financial consulting, investment portfolio management, ... but also research, teaching at research and higher education institutions.

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B. TRAINING OBJECTIVE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

I. Training Objectives

1. General objectives

The Bachelor of Finance - Banking program aims to train graduates with political integrity, ethical standards, and good health. Learners are required to have good business ethics, to master modern knowledge of economics in general, and in-depth knowledge in such areas as finance, banking, risk management, capital management, corporate financial management, financial investment, ... They are also expected to be able to analyze, evaluate, manage, and advise on issues related to finance and banking sector such as banks, investment funds, securities companies, insurance companies, financial companies, state agencies, administrative agencies, state bank, and domestic and foreign companies.

2. Specific objectives

The Bachelor program in Finance and Banking is designed with the objectives of providing learners with the ability to:

G1. Understand and apply basic knowledge of Marxism-Leninism, the revolutionary lines of the Vietnamese Communist Party, and the political ideology of Ho Chi Minh.

G2. Understand and master basic knowledge of the legal fields of finance, banking, and securities.

G3. Master basic knowledge of business administration, accounting, finance, currency, and banking, and in-depth knowledge of specialized fields of finance and banking.

G4. Apply basic and professional knowledge to solve practical problems related to corporate finance (financial planning, corporate valuation, corporate financial analysis, capital mobilization, and utilization, credit management, payment operations, financial investment, appraisal, and banking marketing...).

G5. Evaluate and analyze the financial situation to serve the purpose of making investment decisions, financing decisions, distribution, and control decisions. Prepare financial plans to provide direction for business operations, as a basis for evaluating its financial performance.

G6. Able to appraise asset value, stock value, investment project value, and enterprise value. Able to detect and provide financial risk management solutions at businesses, and credit institutions.

G7. Have the ability to practice, proficiently use software to calculate financial indicators, and be proficient in English in Finance - Banking.

G8. Have reasoning and thinking abilities according to the financial system, solve arising problems, and research knowledge in the field of finance and banking. Have the ability to conduct independent research, self-study, self-experience, and soft skills to develop a career.

G9. Have skills to plan activities, organize and evaluate results and assigned tasks; creatively apply learned knowledge to practical activities.
