1. Name of training program (English name):	ECONOMIC LAW
2. Degree:	The degree of bachelor
3. Training codes:	7380107
4. Admission candidates:	Compliance with the existing University Admission Regulations of the Ministry of Education and Training and the University of Western Doha. Vietnamese citizens who fulfill all the following conditions are eligible for admission: - High school graduate or equivalent. - Be in good health to study and work in accordance with the current regulations of the Ministry of Health - Education and Training. - Full, timely submission of registration papers and fees as prescribed by the Ministry of Education and Training.
5. Training time:	3.5 years (10 semesters, 3 semesters/year)
6. Training form:	Concentration
7. Required credits:	130 credits (This number of credits does not include 11 credits from the two components: Physical Education (03 credits) and Defence – Security Education (08 credits))

9. Diploma:	The degree of bachelor economic law
10. Working position:	The employment opportunities for graduates in the field of Economic Law are currently very promising. Graduates in Economic Law can work in various organizations such as the Department of Planning and Investment, Economic Departments, People's Courts at all levels, People's Procuracy at all levels; People's Council, People's Committee and specialized agencies of People's Committee at all levels; Police, Inspectorate, Judicial Enforcement; Department of Justice, Department of Foreign Affairs, Department of

	Industry and Trade, Tax Department, Customs, legal and human resources departments in domestic and foreign enterprises; working as legal consultants for Law Firms, Law Offices; or engaging in research work in State and legal research institutes, Economic Institutes, etc. In addition, students can also pursue further education and specialize in their field after graduation.

B. TRAINING OBJECTIVE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

I. Training Objectives

1. General objectives

The general objective of the Economic Law training program is to train human resources primarily for domestic and international economic organizations. Additionally, it provides human resources for organizations operating in complementary legal support fields (law firms, notary offices, inheritance offices, etc.). Throughout the training process, the University's goal is to build and provide students with a systematic and professional knowledge, create an environment to cultivate political qualities, ethics, and good health, equip them with in-depth skills in business law, and provide them with fundamental knowledge and research capabilities to handle legal issues arising in the economic sector.

Upon graduation, graduates specializing in Economic Law from the Western University will become legal experts in business, capable of assuming positions related to control and legal regulations in enterprises across all economic sectors and government management agencies. With certain efforts, these graduates can also meet the recruitment needs of government agencies, commercial arbitration centers, consulting service providers, legal support entities, or other non-governmental organizations

2. Specific objectives

Regarding knowledge: The Economic Law training program equips students with fundamental knowledge of the Vietnamese legal system in general and a solid understanding of legal expertise in business activities based on knowledge of economics. Additionally, graduates in Economic Law also have certain knowledge of international commercial law. Specifically, the objectives are as follows:

G1. Basic knowledge of political science and social sciences such as logic, psychology, philosophy, political economy, Ho Chi Minh's ideology, legal methodology and profession, and other subjects that serve as a foundation for studying basic and specialized subjects in the field.

G2. Legal knowledge and practical legal knowledge in the field and group of fields, including general theoretical knowledge of the state and law; knowledge of Vietnamese law and practical legal knowledge in basic legal fields such as civil law and civil litigation, criminal law and criminal litigation, administrative law and administrative litigation,

marriage and family law, and international law sufficient for students to apply the law to solve legal issues arising in society.

G3. Specialized legal knowledge and practical legal knowledge in fields such as commercial contracts, investment law, financial law, insurance business law, securities law, banking law, real estate business law, international trade law, labor law, and social security law.

G4. Knowledge of information technology and foreign languages to meet job requirements; knowledge of entrepreneurship; basic knowledge of management and operation of professional activities; knowledge of planning, organizing, and supervising activities in the legal field.

Regarding skills: Graduates in Economic Law have the following skills:

G6. Skills in searching, analyzing, and evaluating legal documents related to economic law; skills in applying the law to solve legal situations in practice.

G7. Skills in negotiation and contract drafting, legal advisory skills; skills in drafting legal advisory letters and documents for tasks in the field of economic law.

G8. Legal reasoning skills: identifying issues, understanding the legal needs to be addressed, analyzing and synthesizing information, evaluating evidence, making arguments, debating, and making correct assessments according to legal provisions to determine solutions.

G9. Legal advisory skills and professional expertise in business and commerce.

Regarding attitude:

G10. Graduates in Economic Law must respect the law, have a sense of respect for social ethics and professional ethics, and live responsibly towards themselves, their families, and society.

G11. Adopting a scientific working method, continuously striving for learning and improving qualifications; being proactive and creative in solving tasks; cooperating well with colleagues and the community in work and life.

II. Learning outcomes:

2.1 Knowledge

Output standard	Explain
